

PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY COMMISSION (PURC) PUBLICATION OF ELECTRICITY TARIFFS

In accordance with the statutory duty to publish rates approved by the Public Utilities Regulatory Commission under Section 19 of the Public Utilities Regulatory Commission Act 1997 (Act 538), this publication is made this 26th May 2010.

1. The Volta River Authority (VRA) and the Shenzhen Energy Group Company Limited (Shenzhen) shall charge the rates provided for in the First Schedule hereto as Bulk Generation Charges (BGC) to take effect from 1st June 2010.

2. The Ghana Grid Company Limited (GRIDCo) shall charge the rates provided in the Second Schedule hereto as the Transmission Service Charge (TSC) to take effect from 1st June 2010.

3. The Electricity Company of Ghana Limited (ECG) and Northern Electricity Department (NED) of the VRA shall charge the rates provided for in the Third and Fourth Schedules hereto as the Distribution Service Charge (DSC) and End-User Tariffs to take effect from the June 2010 billing cycle.

4. These approved rates shall remain in force until they are changed by the Public Utilities Regulatory Commission.

5. The rates are denominated in Ghana Pesewas.

6. The rates approved by the Public Utilities Regulatory Commission to take effect from 1st July 2008 for VRA, GRIDCo, ECG and NED as published in Gazette No. 54 of 20th June 2008 are hereby accordingly revoked and replaced with the following:

* GRIDCo's tariff of GHp 2.4/kWh includes a regulatory levy of GHp 0.2/kWh of electricity transmitted which is payable to the Public Utilities Regulatory Commission.

FOOTNOTES:

1. Residential consumption above 50 units will not benefit from the subsidized and exclusive lifeline block charge.
2. Residential consumption above 50 units and up to 300 units will attract a tariff of GHp17 per unit for total units consumed.
3. Residential consumption above 300 units and up to 600 units will attract a tariff of GHp 17 per unit for the first 300 units and GHp 21 per unit for consumption above 300 units, but less than 600 units.
4. Residential consumption above 600 units will attract a tariff of GHp 17 per unit for the first 300 units, GHp 21 per unit for the next 300 units, and GHp 23 per unit for consumption above 600 units.
